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Language

Key Vocabulary

Pastimes: *collect (coins), go for a walk, read a book, listen to music, play cards, ...*
Likes / Dislikes: *like, hate, love, enjoy.*
Frequency adverbs: *always, usually, sometimes, never.*

2 A busy life

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Language

*First, he gets up early. Then, ...
I play chess because it is easy for me. I'm good at skating.
How often do you skate? I have practice sessions twice a week.
Why don't we go to the cinema?*

Key Vocabulary

After-school activities: *chess, pottery, drama, painting, ...*
Adverbs: *surprisingly, seriously, hard, luckily, suddenly, ...*
Linking words: *first, then, after that, finally, ...*
Collections: *notes, bottle tops, leaves, shells, marbles, tickets, ...*

3 Wild life

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Language

*Bats are the only mammals that can fly.
Giraffes are the tallest animals in the world.
Blue whales are bigger than elephants.
Do you agree? I don't agree. I think...*

Key Vocabulary

Animals: *lemurs, scorpions, sloths, corals, platypuses, cheetahs, ...*
Adjectives: *fragile, voracious, curious, heavy, fast, slow, strange, ...*
Animal world: *mammals, reptiles, invertebrates, feathers, enclosure, tusks, sting, tentacles, nest, ...*
Large numbers: *100 - 999*

4 Past and present

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Language

*I was born on 12th February. On my last birthday, I played video games. When I was a little child, my hair was short.
Where were you yesterday? I wasn't at home.*

Key Vocabulary

Celebrations: *birthday, party, presents, Christmas, ...*
Ordinal numbers: *first, second, ...*
Past forms: *was / were, loved, liked, played, ...*

5 Natural disasters

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Language

*There was a powerful tornado in 1953. Where was it?
There were many injured people.
There weren't any storms in my area last year.
I watched San Andreas last night. I don't recommend it. It's boring!*

Key Vocabulary

Natural events: *hurricanes, tornadoes, tsunamis, earthquakes, volcanic eruptions, floods, droughts, wild fires, ...*
Past forms: *There was / were*
Time adverbials: *yesterday morning, last night, last week, two hours ago, ...*

6 Time travel

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Language

*Incan children didn't go to school.
What did they do during the day?
They helped and learned from their families.
Did they fish in the river? Yes, they did.
I'm digging because I'm going to plant a tree.*

Key Vocabulary

Ancient times: *civilisation, empire, temples, ceremonies, ancestors, ...*
Archaeology: *excavations, artifacts, mummy, Egyptian coffin, archaeological sites, ...*
Past forms of regular verbs: *travelled, visited, used, studied, lived, cooked, ...*
